One of his prominent cases includes having acted for a number of minority subsidiary proprietors who objected to the SG\$500 million collective sale of the condominium development, Horizon Towers. The Singapore Court of Appeal reversed the earlier decisions of the Strata Titles Board and the Singapore High Court and allowed the appeal by the minority represented by the Firm. This landmark decision not only marks the first time that the Court of Appeal has decided in favour of minority owners in a disputed en bloc sale in Singapore, but also set out the extent of the duties of a sales committee and the responsibility of the Strata Titles Board in an en-bloc transaction.

Justin is a member of The Law Society of Singapore and a Fellow of Singapore Institute of Arbitrators. He is called to the Bar of Brunei Darussalam and has practised there. He is also gazetted as counsel to appear on behalf of the Government of the Republic of Singapore in civil proceedings for claims relating to State land.
